Overseeing all aspects of the scheme from inception to completion and sale.

Create and maintain scheme development appraisals, regularly reviewing inputs and outputs for the purposes of project management and company business planning.

Help to ensure all legal agreements associated with a project are complete and accurate and properly reflect the Company and the wider JV's understanding of the transaction/risk profile.
